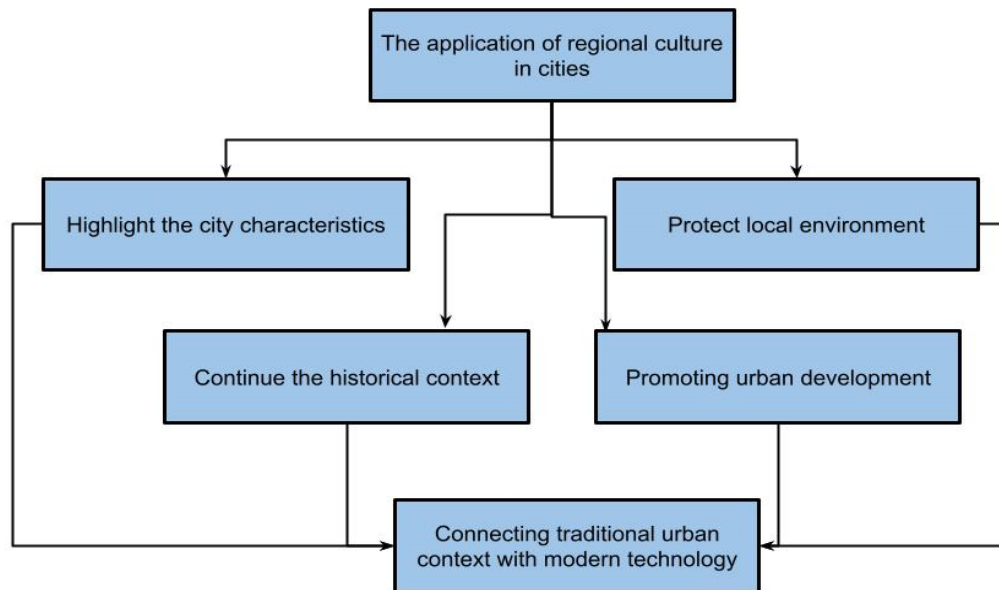


Figure 2- The relation between regional culture and city

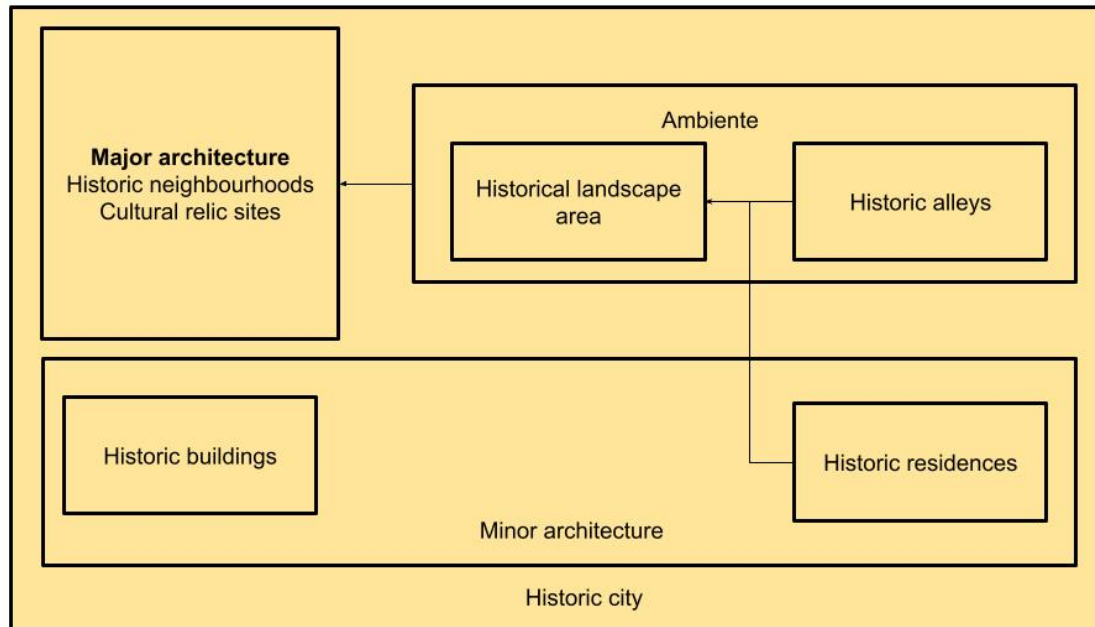


Figure 3. Structure of protection plan for Changsha. [11]

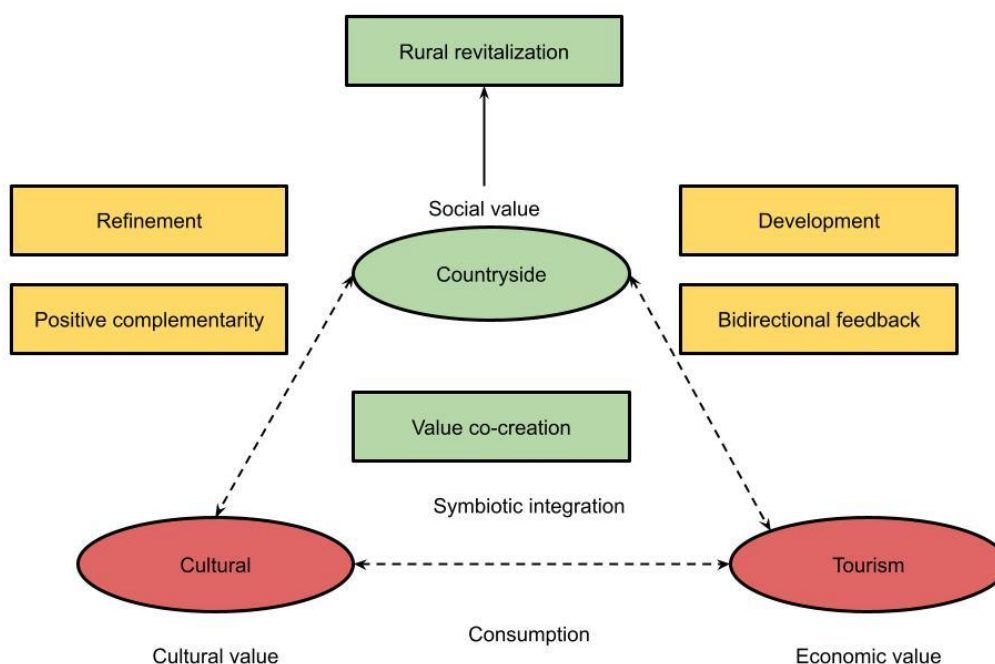


Figure 5. The countryside, culture, and tourism relationship.

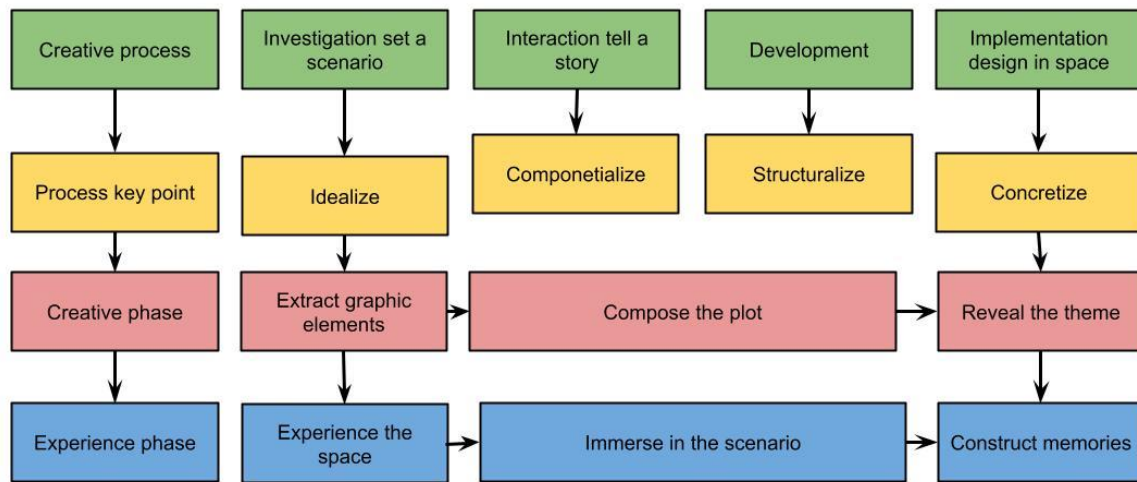


Figure 6. Research model of cultural sustainability of environmental graphics in a rural cultural tourism space
